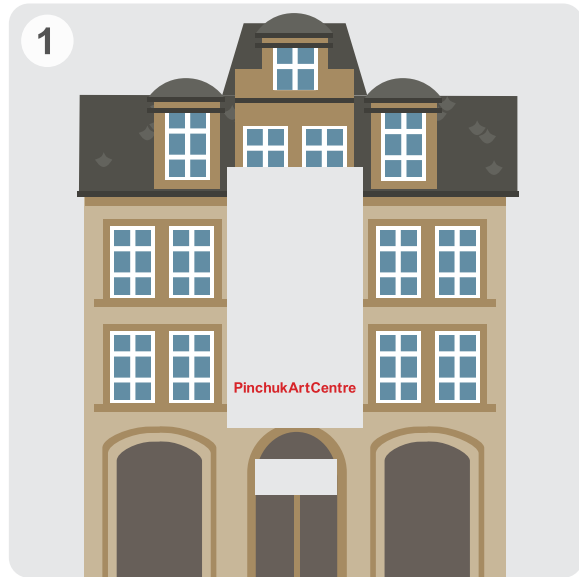

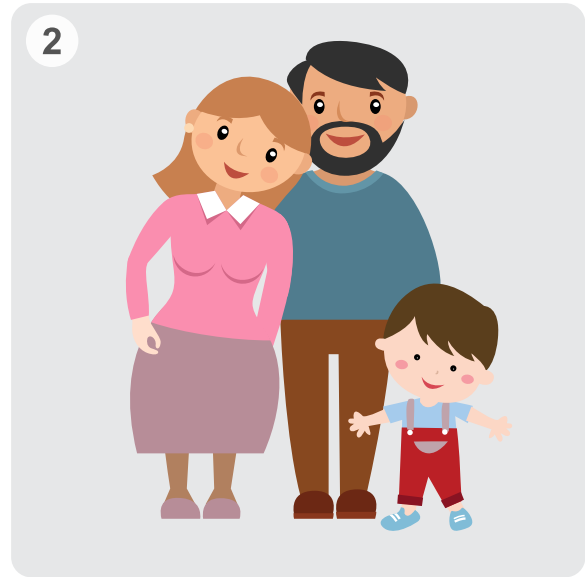

WE GO TO THE MUSEUM!



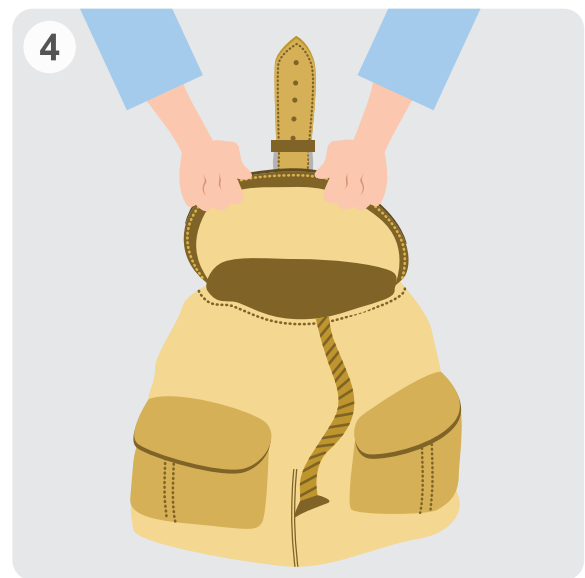
Today I go to the PinchukArtCentre.

There will be a security guard at the entrance.



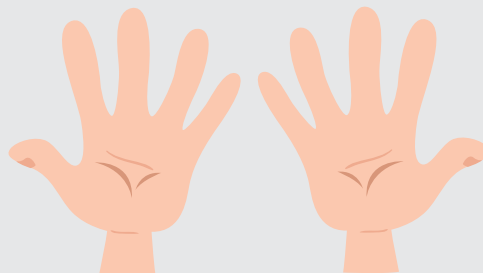
He will ask me to show him the contents of my bag and I will open it.

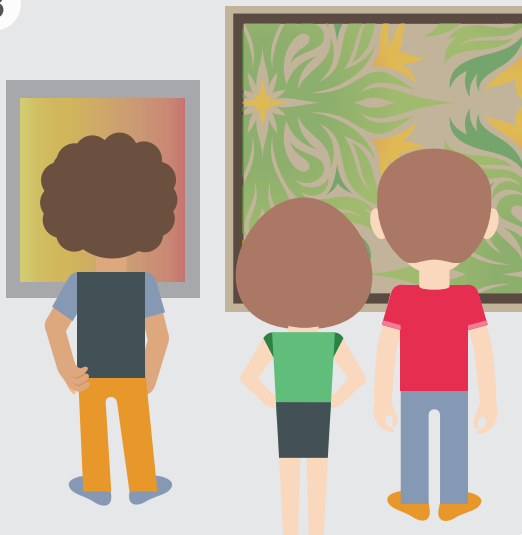
Now my hands are free.

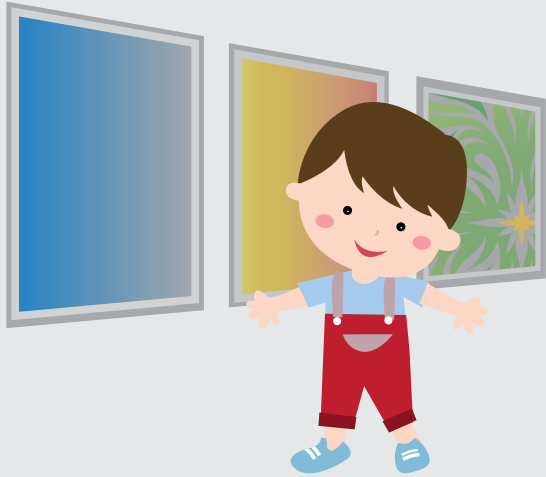
A lot of people can be in PinchukArtCentre.

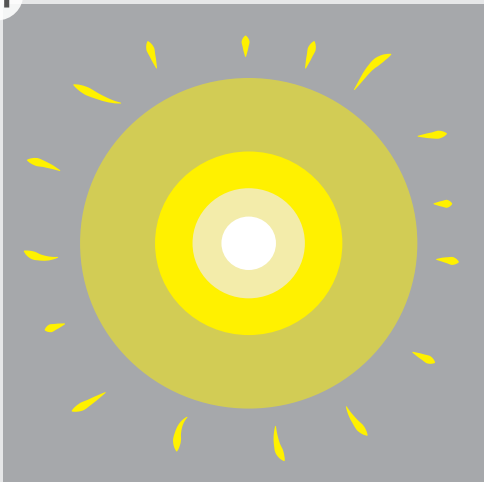
I will also stop and look.

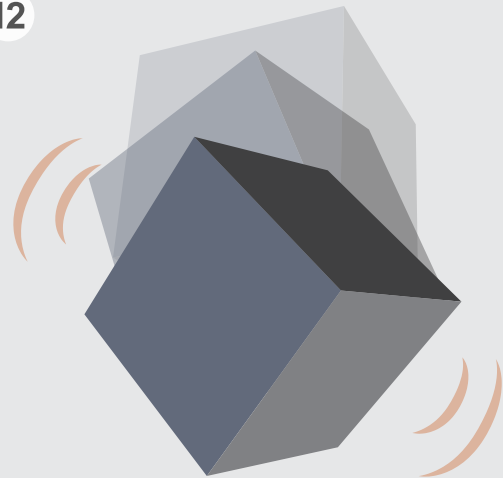
Some objects can make sounds.

I can look at them with my eyes.



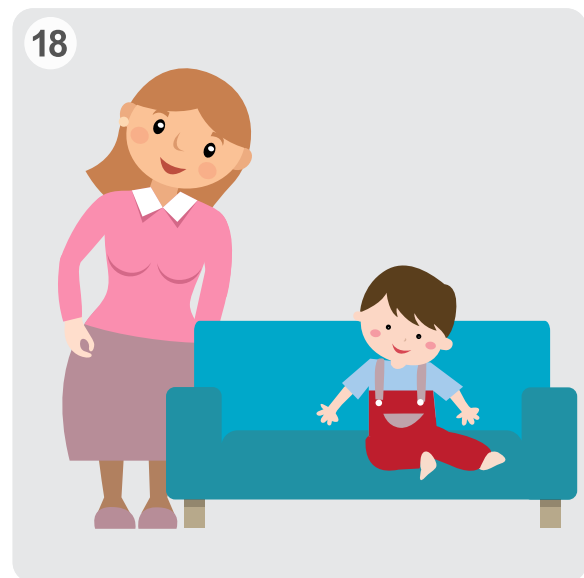
I can talk about art.
